1. **VISIT:** On your own time, visit a clear cut or heavily-logged area, in the Coast Range, as close to Hillsboro as possible. From Hwy 26 and Glencoe Road (reset your trip odometer here)... At 14.9 miles pass under Tillamook Railroad Bridge, at 16.5 miles pass through tunnel, at 17.0 miles pass red-tiled roof house on right, at 17.5 miles see foot path on right, at 17.9 miles see start of big pull out area on right, at 18.2 miles see forest road on right, and at 21.5 miles see considerable clear cutting on the left side.
2. **PHOTOS:** Take photographs of you (with peers or family) in that setting. You must get as close as *safely* possible. No distant viewing.
3. **HAND-WRITTEN OBSERVATIONS:** Write 3 (or more) observations of the area, as you stand in it. Hint: Bring writing materials, note pad, comp book, etc.
4. **HAND-WRITTEN REFLECTION:** Spend 10 minutes quietly writing down your thoughts and feelings at the time.

NOTE: You don't need complete sentences – just get it down. Your photos are to prove you were there, so you must be **in** them. You'll show me your photos, and turn in your **hand-written** observations and reflection. ***Your final product should be about 1 page of writing.***
